- Duration:** March 2015-February 2018 (3 years)
- Place:** Sukhpur union council, Thatta District, Sindh province, The Islamic Republic of Pakistan
- Targets:** Premarital girls playing a main role in health care of their family
- Objective:** To enhance women to acquire knowledge on how to protect themselves and their family members from common illness.
- Activity:** The project will provide trainings to women with the expectation that the trained women will cascade their knowledge to their families or neighborhoods.
